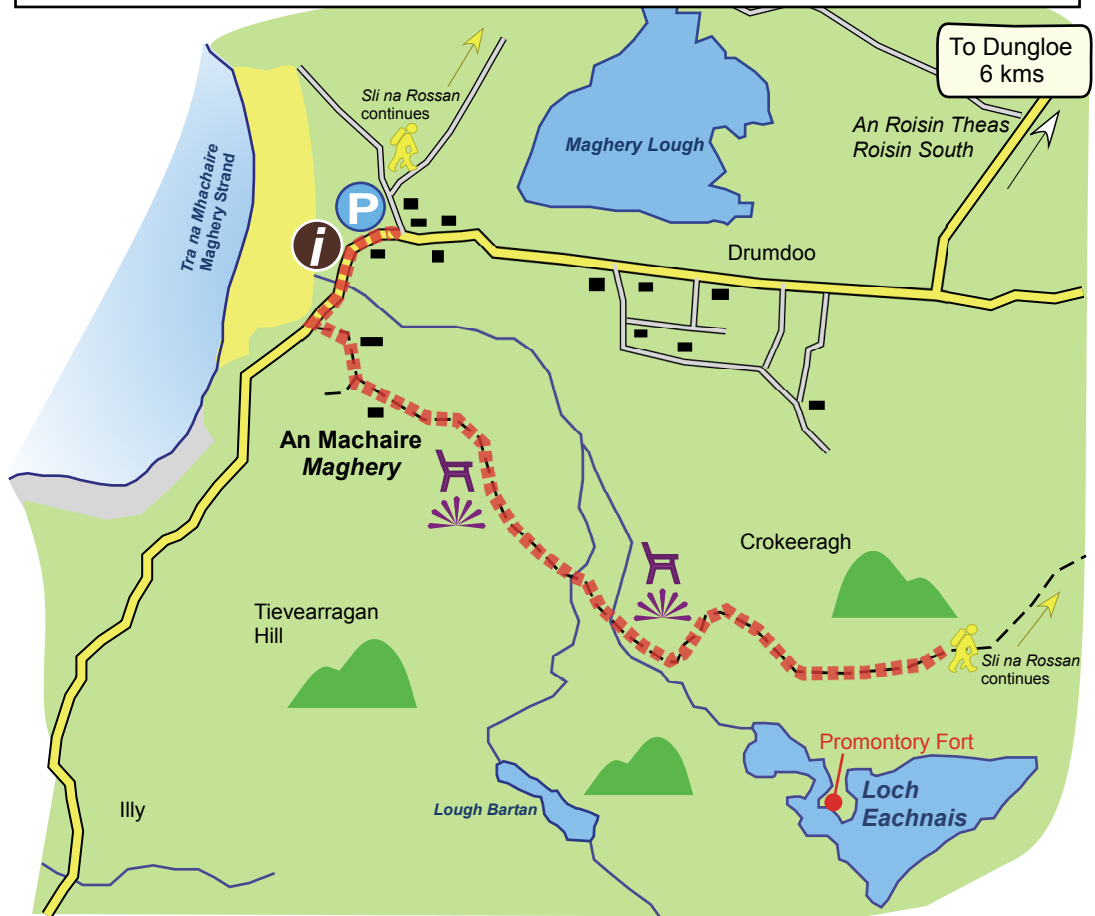

Walk Details

This walk forms part of *Sli na Rossan* (National Waymarked Way) but is an excellent short walk on its own. Shortly after leaving the beach/car park you are in quiet countryside with excellent views over the Rosses and out towards Aranmore Island.

- Distance:** Approximately 4 kms (there and back)
- Time:** 30 minutes to 1 hour
- Terrain:** Rough track, quiet roads.
- Grading:** Moderate. Although the walk is only moderately difficult, there is a relatively steep climb to begin with.

Take the N56 from either Glenties/Ardara or Dungloe and follow the signs for An Machaire
